Course Description:		Within the scope of the course, first of all, the basic concepts, purpose and historical development of execution law are discussed. After evaluating its place and function in the criminal justice system, the principles applicable in execution law, the concept of punishment, types of punishment and execution systems are examined. Practical issues such as suspension of the execution of the sentence, reasons preventing execution and the admission process to execution institutions are included. The classification of convicts, the planning of the execution, the rights and obligations of the convicts during the execution process and the supervision of the execution are covered in detail. Regimes applied in penal institutions, execution reductions and set-off procedures, probation practice and special forms of execution are emphasized. In addition, in the execution regime specific to repeaters and in the execution law Competent authorities and the execution procedure process are also among the important topics of the course.
