The content includes general first-aid principles, patient/injured assessment methods, basic life support, bleeding, injuries, burns, fractures-dislocations-sprains, poisoning, drowning, heat and cold exposure, heart attack, and stroke emergencies.							

In addition, first aid in accidents and disasters, carrying techniques, and safety measures are

taught, enabling students to gain both theoretical knowledge and practical skills.
