The concept of tort, conditions and consequences of liability based on fault, compensation for material damage in liability based on fault, cases of liability without fault, equity and danger liability, material and moral compensation, provisions to be applied in case of more than one reason for liability, unjust enrichment, culpa in contrahendo and fiduciary liability, performance of obligations and consequences of non-performance, special obligation relations, joint indebtedness, contingent obligations, transfer of receivables and assumption of debt.
