This course focuses on the field of law that deals with consumer transactions, in which one party is consumer and the other is the seller or provider. It aims to inform students about consumer rights with the framework of consumer protection legislation and to equip them with practical solutions that can applied in potential consumer disputes. The course covers the historical development of consumer its constitutional foundations, its relationship with other branches of law, and its place within broader legal system. Key concepts such as consumer, seller/provider, and consumer transaction examined. The scope of the Law on the Protection of Consumers is defined, including defective goard services, liability of the seller arising from defects, consumer rights in the case of defective goard services, and liability for damages caused by defective goods. 
