- 2. The background or motivation for choosing the topic
- 3. The broader context of the research

Literature Review

- Summary of key academic studies related to the topic.
- The theoretical framework of the research.
- Identified gaps or debates in the literature.
- How your research will contribute to the existing body of knowledge...

Research Questions & Hypothesis

- Research Questions: What exactly is the study trying to answer? ⁽ⁱ⁾
- Hypotheses: Assumptions to be tested.
- This section defines the focus of the study!
- AIM AND OBJECTIVES!! PURPOSE OF THE STUDY...



Be careful! You should present both RQ and Hypotheses!

Methodology

- The methodology will be designed to answer and approve the research questions!!
- **Type of research:** Quantitative, qualitative, mixed methods, experimental, etc...
- Population and sample: Who will be involved? How many participants? (SHOULD BE IN DETAIL!) Please take notes in the <u>class!</u>
- **Data collection methods:** Surveys, interviews, observations etc.
- Data analysis techniques: Statistical tools, content analysis, descriptive stats, etc. (e.g. SPSS, R Statistics, Lisrel...)
- Mention any tools, resources...

Ethical Consideration & Possible Limitations

- Ethical principles to be followed (e.g., informed consent, confidentiality)
- Potential limitations of the research (sample size, time constraints, etc.)

Conclusion

A summary of your research! –Just to summarize all the information!

References

Do not forget to use APA 7 FORMAT!

Extra Tips! 🕲

- Slide count: Max. 15 is ideal ③
- Keep slides simple and visual (please, avoid long paragraphs)...
- Highlight core parts: Introduction, Literature Review, Methodology.
- Practice timing before your presentation! Usually you'll have 10–15 minutes to present as a group.
