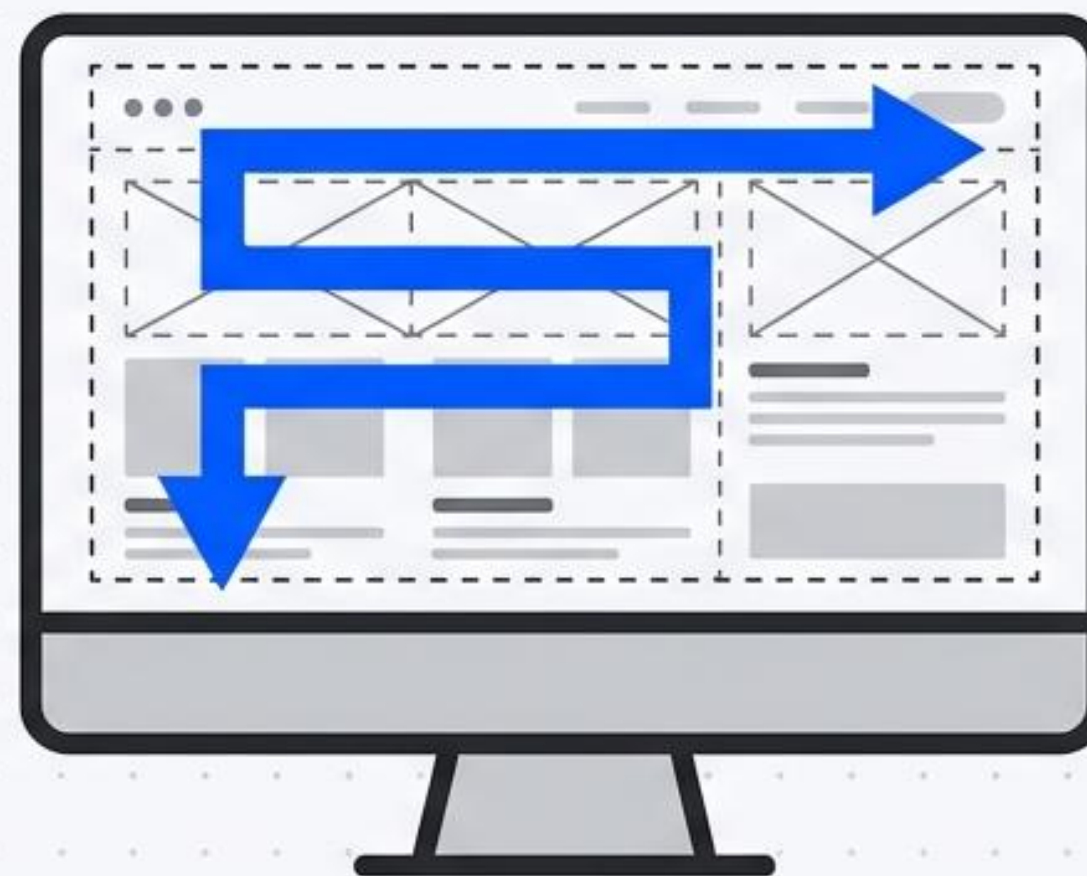

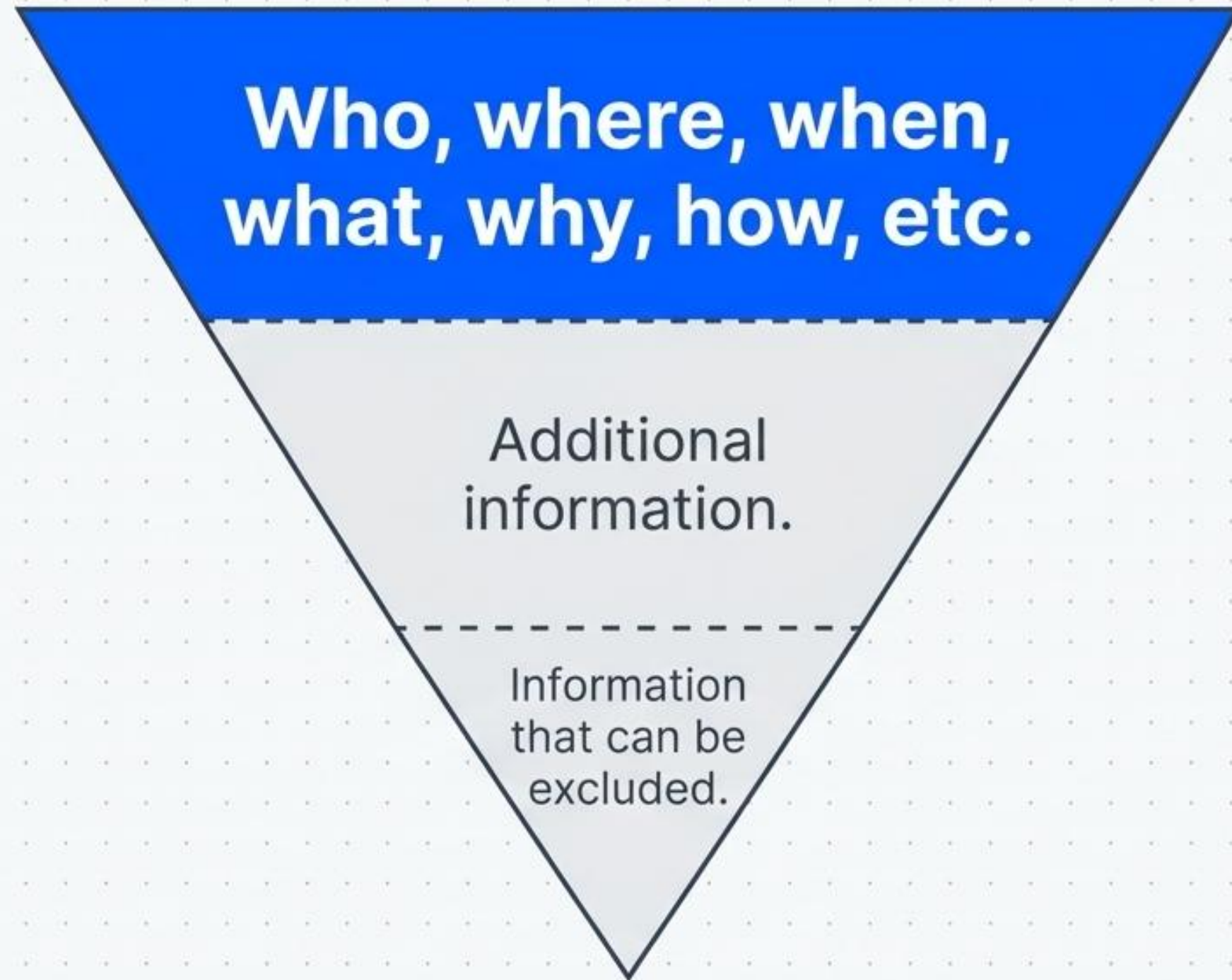


Linear Consumption:

The Inverted Pyramid: The structural blueprint of digital content.

The Critical Zone.

Front-load key terminology here. There is no room for ambiguity. This layer drives user retention and Search Engine Optimization (SEO).

The Flow Zone.

Elaborate on concepts while maintaining natural linguistic flow.

The Cut Zone.

A safe area for linguistic nuance, but easily truncated if UI space is strictly limited.

Strict character limits apply. Expanding a translated word can break the site design.

Action-Oriented:

Dominated by imperatives and short nouns. The goal is wayfinding, not storytelling.

Decontextualized:

Translators often receive these strings isolated in Excel sheets without visual context.

Fluid Formatting

SEO Sensitive

Requires strategic, natural integration of localized search keywords.

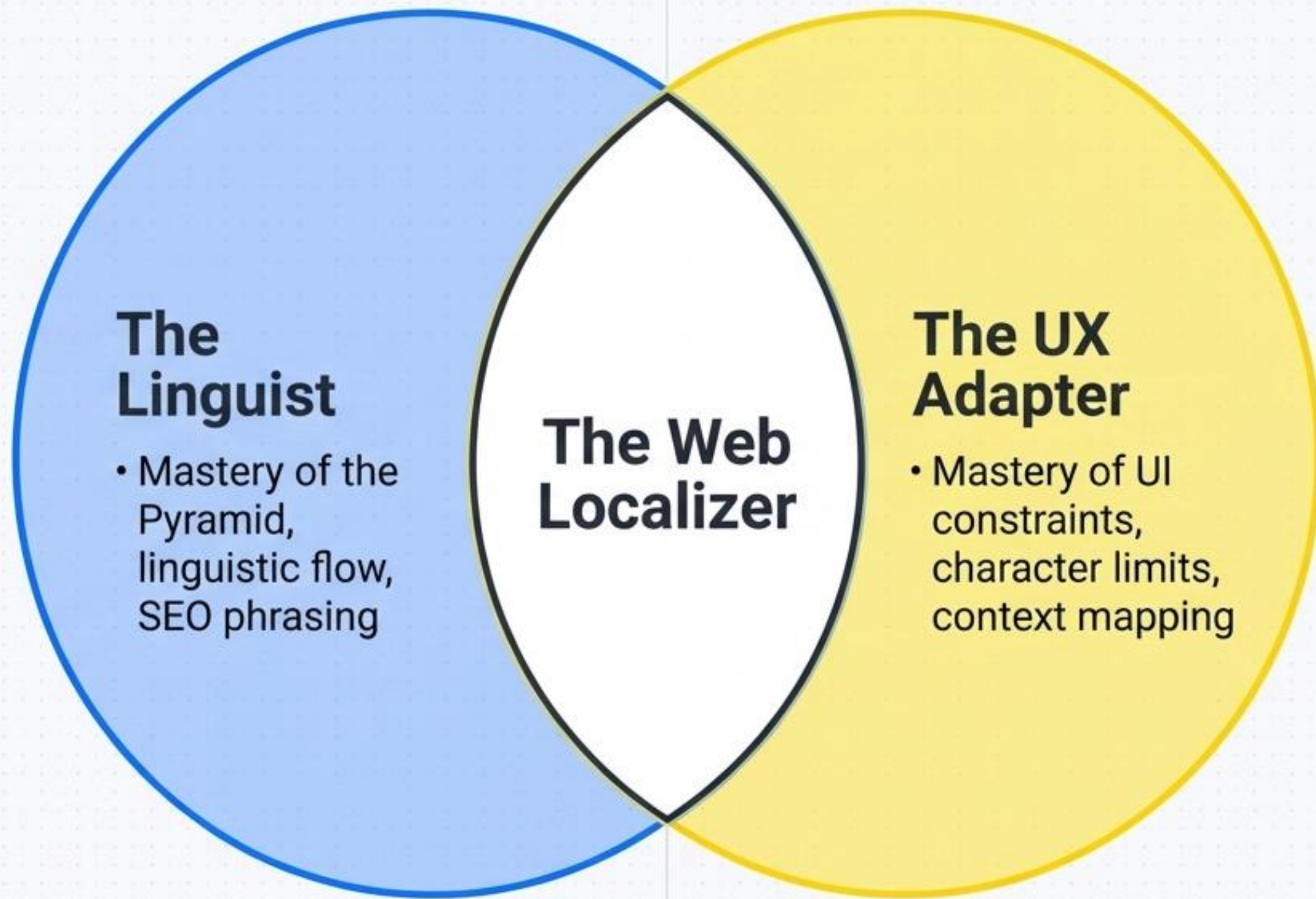

The String Expansion Challenge:

English is highly compact. Turkish localization often requires longer character counts or distinct grammatical structures that challenge pre-designed interface limits.



You are no longer just translating a text; you are adapting a digital product. Success requires a dual mindset.

- ✓ Categorize the source text: Am I translating Interface or Content?
- ✓ Request character limits for all UI elements before beginning.
- ✓ Ask the client for visual context (screenshots) for isolated strings.
- ✓ Front-load crucial terminology into the top of the Inverted Pyramid.
