Project Instructions:

You are participating in an international student exchange program. Your task is to select <u>one perfect gift</u> for your new exchange friend. You must choose a gift from their country (not your own) and write why your present is the perfect present. (*Your text should be around 80 words.*)

Language Requirements:

You must only use these grammar rules:

Tense: Only Present Simple Tense (I like, she works, he is)

Focus: Use Possessive Adjectives (my, his, her)

Words: Use words for Countries, Routines, Food & Drink, and Adjectives.

Project Structure and Steps:

Your text must have three parts.

Part 1: Your Friend's Life and Country

In this part, you introduce your friend and their basic life.

- ♣ Say your friend's name and their country. (Use am/is/are and adjectives to say what he or she is like.)
 - For example: My new friend is Sofia. She is from Italy. She is a busy and friendly person.
- **♣** Talk about his or her day. (Use the Present Simple Tense to say what he or she does every day. Say when he or she wakes up and when classes start.)
- ♣ Talk about his or her food and drinks. (Say what he or she likes and does not like to eat.)

Part 2: The Present and Description

In this part, you choose the present and describe it.

♣ Say what the present is (for example, a coffee maker or special food).

- ♣ Say why this present is important for his or her country's culture. For example: *I choose one special Italian coffee maker. This item is important for her home country's culture* because coffee is very popular in Italy and the first and most important drink every morning.
- ♣ Describe the present. Use adjectives (like *small*, *beautiful*, *etc*.). For example: *The coffee maker is small*. *It has only one cup*.

Part 3: Why the Present is Perfect

This is the most important part. You must explain **why** the present is the perfect choice. You must use logic!

♣ Explain how the gift is good for his or her daily routine. Use hours and action verbs. Use Possessive Adjectives.

For example: She wakes up early, and she studies a lot. She needs coffee to begin her day. The coffee maker is perfect for her busy schedule, and it is good for her energy.
