Topic: The Community Service Priority List

Imagine you are a social service student leading a small volunteer group. You have only 5 hours and 3 volunteers to help your community. You cannot do everything! Your task is to look at the list of 5 important community projects and logically decide which 3 projects you choose to do in those 5 hours. You must write a short report to explain your choices and say why the chosen 3 are more important than the others. Your report should be around 90 words.




The Projects (The Challenge)

You must choose only **3** of these 5 projects

-  **Project A:** Food Drive - Collect necessary food for 10 hungry families.
-  **Project B:** Park Cleanup - Clean the local park to make the area nice.
-  **Project C:** English Class - Teach a simple English lesson for 5 new immigrant adults.
-  **Project D:** Hospital Visit - Visit 4 elderly people in the hospital who are alone.
-  **Project E:** Clothes Collection - Collect warm winter clothes for 20 children.

Language Requirements & Constraints




Your writing should include:

-  Present Simple Tense (for describing facts and actions).
-  Possessive Adjectives (his/her/their), Simple Adjectives (e.g., *important, hungry, necessary, safe*)
-  Modal Verbs (can, cannot for priority and rules) and Basic Comparison (e.g., *Project A is more important than Project B*).



Part1: State the three chosen projects and the two projects you cannot do.

Example: We choose Project A, Project D, and Project E. We cannot choose Project B and Project C.

Part 2: Explain the logic behind your choices using comparison and Modals.

-  **Priority 1 (Basic Need):** Explain why one project (A or E) is the most important.
Example: Project A is more urgent than Project B, because hungry families must eat.
-  **Priority 2 (Health/Social Need):** Explain why Project D is necessary.
Example: The elderly people are alone. We must visit them, because social support is important for their health.
-  **Exclusions:** Explain why you cannot do one of the non-chosen projects (B or C)
Example: We cannot do Project C, because teaching needs more than 5 hours.

Part 3: Write a conclusion summarizing your action logic.

-  **Conclusion:** Say the first and most important principle for choosing social work
Example: The first important rule is that we must help the people who need food and help right now.
-  **Volunteer Rule:** Say one rule for the three volunteers.
Example: The volunteers must work fast and safe.
